

1 National Planning Board

Controlled primarily by central
government ministries

Prepares: National outline plans (for the approval of the Cabinet).

Approves: Regional plans.

6 District (Regional) Planning Commissions Controlled primarily by central government ministries

National

Regional

Local

Prepares: Regional and local plans.

Approves: Any Local plan.

Following the 2014 Reforms Districts gave up their exclusive power to approve certain local plans.

125 Local Planning Authorities Controlled by local council members

Prepares: Some local plans that require regional approval.

Approves: Other types of local plans (those that do no

require regional consent).

Following the 2014 Reforms localities can manage and approve a greater number of local plans.




What is the degree of centralization in Israeli Planning?








Certification of Local Planning Commissions in Israel










